The School for Student Leadership (SSL) is specifically for 2022 Year 9 students and requires the students to live onsite at the Alpine School Campus for Term 1 2022. Whilst there, the students experience personal and group challenges continuing to develop skills such as resilience, team working and problem-solving skills and apply this through their Community Learning Project (CLP) specific to the Lara community. Prior to attending the students will be working with staff to begin their CLP project which is then fully developed whilst at the SSL ready for completion upon their return. It must, in some shape or form, positively impact the Lara Community.

We have been successful in our application for students to attend, and have been informed by the SSL that we can send a team of 5 students, 2 males and 3 females. In support of this, schools are also encouraged to develop a second team who remains at school and supports the development of the CLP, being an integral part of its success. All costs involved will be covered by Lara Secondary College, and selected students will be involved in fundraising before attending the SSL to help support this.

Interested students are able to download and complete an application form from the college website, which must be endorsed by a parent/guardian prior to submission.
