Please note the following:		

- 1. Each student's enrolment in music lessons will be for the duration of the school year. If a student wishes to unenroll, discontinuation must be signed by the parents/guardians in writing and received 4 weeks prior to the end of the term in progress. Student cancellations are not acceptable methods of notification.
- 2. The term fee (\$75 for group \$125 for solo) is a non-refundable payment, should a student cease instrumental lessons during the term without proper notice. A credit of remaining term fees will be applied if conditions in Point 1 have been honored.
- 3. As these lessons are heavily subsidised by Lara Secondary College, payments are calculated by a term charge rather than a per lesson charge. All payments must be paid with cash or via the Compass parent portal. Payment plans can be arranged with the Front Office.
- 4. Lara Secondary College reserves the right to withhold instrumental lessons if term payments are outstanding or overdue. Term payments are due 4 weeks prior to the commencement of the following school term.
- 5. The subsidised term charges will allow for any lessons that may be cancelled due to school events or public holidays, as make up lessons cannot be arranged. Students are encouraged to check their Compass Timetable to ensure lessons times are accounted for.
- 6. In the case that a hired instrument is damaged, negotiation with families will take place prior to repair and required payment.
